# APPENDIX G

## FISH AND WILDLIFE SPECIES LIST

This Appendix contains a list of terrestrial and aquatic vertebrate species found or expected in the Yolo Bypass Wildlife Area. The list was compiled in consultation with Dave Feliz, Area Manager of the Yolo Wildlife Area; Jon King, an author of the official bird checklist for Yolo County (Yolo Audubon Society 2004); and other sources.

### Explanation of Symbols

- SS - indicates special-status species, described in more detail in Section 3.5
- NN - indicates species known to be nonnative
- NV - indicates species expected but not verified on site
- BC - indicates species with a breeding colony on site
- a - indicates anadromous
- b - indicates non-colonial species known to breed on site
- r - indicates species that are resident (present on site throughout the year), but that are not necessarily known to breed
- s - indicates species primarily present in summer (may also be present during spring and fall migration)
- w - indicates species primarily present in winter (may also be present during spring and fall migration)
- m - indicates species present primarily during migration (spring and/or fall; they may be seen in smaller numbers in other seasons)
- x - indicates vagrants, species that have been documented on site only rarely
